# Passenger Endorsement

## Frequently asked questions

### **What is a “P” Endorsement?**

A “P” Endorsement is an endorsement on your licence which allows you to DRIVE a vehicle for the carriage of fare paying customers.

### **What is required to obtain a “P” Endorsement?**

To obtain a “P” Endorsement you must complete the approved Passenger endorsement course to competency standard.

### **Where do I get the information required for such an assessment?**

Triple “A” Driver Training Centre will supply you with all the resource material and application forms.

### **Who will conduct this assessment?**

Triple “A” Driver Training Centre will conduct the assessment at their office in Newlands.

### **What type of assessment is it?**

This is a **closed book** assessment. You are not permitted to take the hand book into the assessment with you and you will have to show the assessor that you understand its content.

### **How long will it take to complete the assessments?**

You are required to attend a 5 hour course for the *P Endorsement* and a 5 hour course for *Fatigue Management Work time rule and log books*.

In addition to this you will need to allow 3-4 hours to complete both the assessments. You will also need to allow for study in your own time.

### **What marks will I need to achieve to pass?**

You are required to complete to competency standard of 100%

### **Do I get the results at the conclusion of the assessment?**

Generally you will receive the results straight away, and if successfully completed you will receive an original certificate which you then take into a licensing agent.
